



PEAK Infrastructure has launched a scholarship program with Katalyst, which aims to bridge gender disparities in corporate India. The program supports women from low income communities through the pursuit of professional education.

Running over four years, the program provides students with researched curriculum, mentorship and industry, corporate and operational exposure. The goal of the PEAK scholarship program is to support the students through their professional education and provide them with employment opportunities post university graduation.

PEAK Scholarship Program

To date, the scholarship program has achieved:

- Signing on the students

- Students have started attending the training program (16 hours a month)
